CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR EMPANELMENT OF INSTRUCTORS (DEAF) AND INTERPRETERS

ISLRTC invites application from eligible candidates to prepare the Panel of Instructors (Deaf) and Panel of Interpreters.

Application Procedure

The completed application with detailed resume and self-attested copies of all the required documents should be submitted by Google Forms on or before **28th October 2022**.

Candidates who have given final 2nd year exams of DTISL or DISLI in December 2021 are eligible to apply based on submission of provisional marksheet.

Late application / incomplete application / applications without attested / self-attested certificate copies of academic qualification, experience, date of birth and category will be summarily rejected.

Important Instructions/ Eligibility Conditions/ Empanelment Norms

Please read the following carefully before applying.

1. Based on the eligibility criteria, eligible candidates will be empanelled. An internal committee of ISLRTC will consider all the applications received for empanelment and the decision of the committee will be final. No other query will be entertained.
2. The minimum eligibility for each post has to be met. It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that they fulfill the eligibility conditions.
3. These posts are purely temporary and posts may increase/decrease as per need.
4. If selected, candidates may be required to join the work on daily basis immediately as and when required.



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5. Empanelled candidates will be engaged as Instructor (Deaf) or as Interpreter as per the need of the task and at the discretion of ISLRTC.
6. Empanelment of a candidate on the Panel of Instructors (Deaf) or Panel of Interpreters does not guarantee appointment as Instructor (Deaf) or Interpreter at ISLRTC for any task.
7. Based on requirement, the empanelled candidates will be engaged as Instructor (Deaf) or Interpreter to carry out any responsibility or work given by ISLRTC. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Taking classes for DISLI and DTISL as and when required
 - b. Signing for ISL videos of various projects
 - c. Conducting short term trainings in physical or online mode
 - d. Conducting awareness sessions
 - e. Interpreting for various meetings, programmes, trainings, etc.
 - f. Etc.

Apart from above, any other responsibility may also be given as per the need of the Centre.

8. The Instructor (Deaf) and Interpreter may be expected to be physically present at ISLRTC office or other venues in Delhi or outside Delhi, or to attend work in online mode.
9. Preference will be given to Instructors who have completed the Training of Trainers workshop conducted by ISLRTC from 4th to 6th August 2022.
10. The Panel of Instructors (Deaf) and Panel of Interpreters will be valid for a period of 01 year from the date of announcement of the Panel.
11. The maximum number of days in a month for which an individual Instructor/Interpreter can be engaged is 12 days. However, in exceptional cases, as per the requirement of the task (project/ training/etc. that require the same Instructor/ Interpreter), the engagement may be for more than 12 days with the approval of the competent authority.
12. Remuneration: Rs 2,000/- per day + local conveyance/TA/DA as per the following norms:
 - a. For online assignments, no local conveyance/TA/DA will be given.
 - b. For local assignments, local conveyance will be given as follows:
 - i. Actual fare by any type of Public Bus/A.C. Bus (only on presentation of original tickets)
 - ii. Journey by auto rickshaw, own scooter, motorcycle etc. @ Rs. 12/- per km.
 - iii. Journey by own car/Taxi, etc. @ Rs. 16 per km. (subject to production of bills)
 - c. For outstation assignments, the TA/DA/accommodation rates are as follows.
 - i. TA for outstation travel:
 - A. A.C. III Tier by train/bus (only on presentation of original tickets)
 - B. Local Journey by auto rickshaw/bus @ Rs. 12/- per km.
 - C. Local Journey by car/Taxi etc. @.Rs. 16 per km. (subject to production of bills)
 - ii. D.A. (Outstation) = Rs 750/- per day
 - iii. Accommodation (Outstation) = Rs 850/- per day (on production of bill of accommodation)
