

Admission related Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What is full form of DTISL and DISLI course? Who can study DTISL and DISLI?

Answer. The full form of DTISL is Diploma in Teaching Indian Sign Language (DTISL). The full form of DISLI is Diploma in Indian Sign Language Interpretation. Only Deaf candidates can study DTISL.

2. What is the benefit of studying DTISL or DISLI course?

Answer. After successfully completing DTISL course, the Deaf candidates will be become Teacher of ISL as a subject. They teach to interpreters, officials, students etc. After successfully completing DISLI course, the Hearing candidates will be become Interpreter of ISL in different settings namely educational, conference, workshop etc.

3. What is date for opening and closing date for online application?

Answer. In this regard, RCI issues circular/notices from time to time. Please follow RCI circular/notice on the RCI website- www.rehabcouncil.nic.in regularly for the latest updates.

4. Whether classes are conducted online or face to face (Physical mode)?

Answer. For both the courses DTISL and DISLI, it is compulsory to attend classes face to face regularly. But, due to COVID-19 pandemic situation, currently classes are conducted in online mode until further order by the Govt. authority/Local body.

5. What is the admission procedure?

Answer. Before COVID-19 pandemic, All India Online Aptitude Test (AIOAT) was being conducted by RCI for all Diploma courses annually. But during the time of Covid-19, admission in DTISL and DISLI will be done on the merit basis as per RCI circular. After filling the online application, RCI will prepare and issue the list of eligible candidates based on the merit of percentage in 12th class.

6. Can I deposit fee in advance to get admission?

Answer. No. Fee can't be paid in advance. If your name is on the merit list prepared by RCI, then you will be called for counseling for documents verification. And after document verification, you will be given provisional admission and directed to deposit the requisite fee.

7. What is the current fee structure of DTISL and DISLI?

Answer. The current fee structure of DTISL/DISLI course is given below semester wise:

1 st semester	– 10,000+5000=15000/-
2 nd Semester-	10,000/-
3 RD Semester-	10,000/-
4 TH Semester-	10.-000/-

Total: 45,000/-

Out of total 45,000/-, Rs. 40,000/- is charged as tuition fee. And Rs. 5000/- is charged as caution money 5000/- which is refundable only after completion of the course with subject to condition.

8. What is the mode of payment for the fees?

Cash is not accepted. Other mode of payment will be announced soon.

9. What is the duration of the DTISL & DISLI course?

Both the above mentioned courses are of 2 years duration spilt over four semesters.

10. Can Hearing candidates apply for DTISL course?

No, only deaf candidates can apply for the DTISL course as per RCI norms given in the syllabus.

11. Whether accommodation provided after admission?

Answer. Currently ISLRTC does not provide any accommodation to any candidate.

12. If I am selected on the national result/1st round of admission etc, what shall I do?

Answer. If your name is allotted to ISLRTC as per result, then you need to visit ISLRTC within stipulated time as per RCI further instruction with the following original documents with copies given below.

- i) 10th passing certificate (02 copies)
- ii) 12th passing certificate (02 copies)
- iii) Original Demand draft in favor of Indian Sign Language Research & Training Centre- payable at New Delhi. Amount - 15000/-rupees. - 02 copies
- iv) Aadhaar Card- 02 copies
- v) Passport photo size- 04
- vi) Reserved category (if applicable)- 02 copies
- vii) Disability certificate (if applicable)- 02 copies

13. What if I quit the course before completion?

Answer. You need to inform your Batch Coordinator for the same. No refund of tuition fee is done under any circumstances.

14. Is stipend available in ISLRTC for studying DTISL or DISLI course?

Answer. Till Academic Session 2020-22, stipend is available. From academic session 2021-23, the Centre is yet to decide on the matter of stipend.
