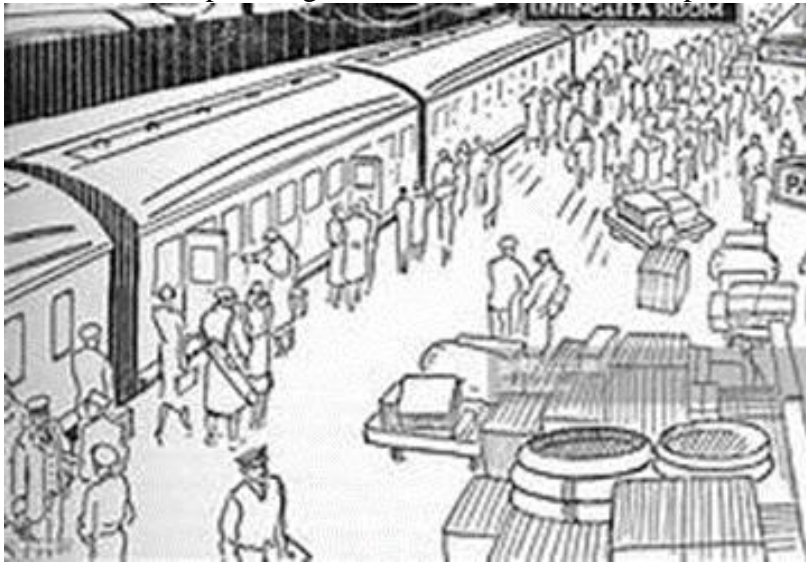

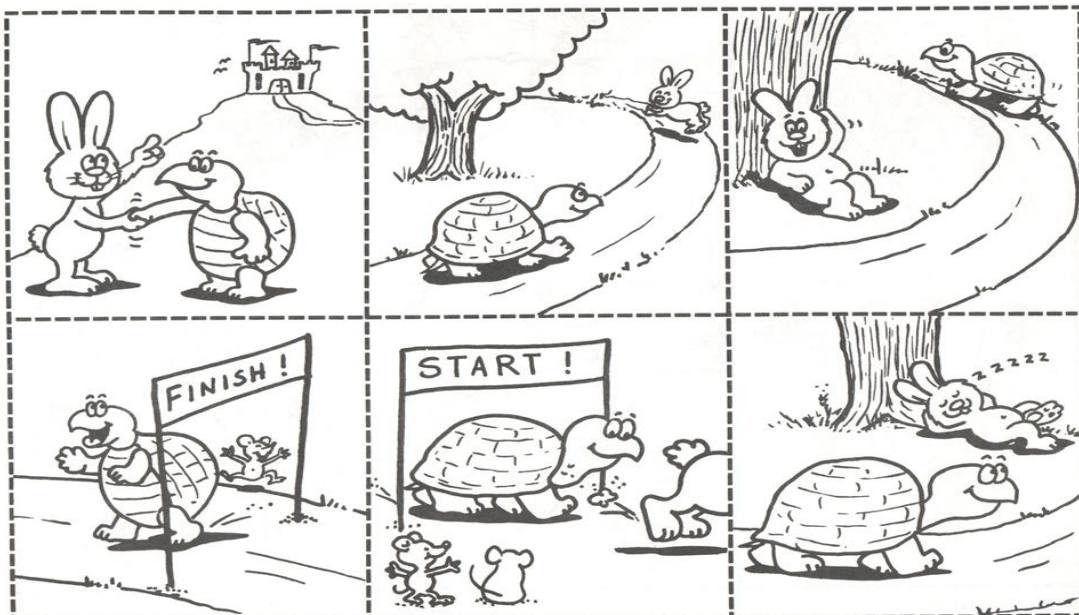

Sun, Stars and Moon

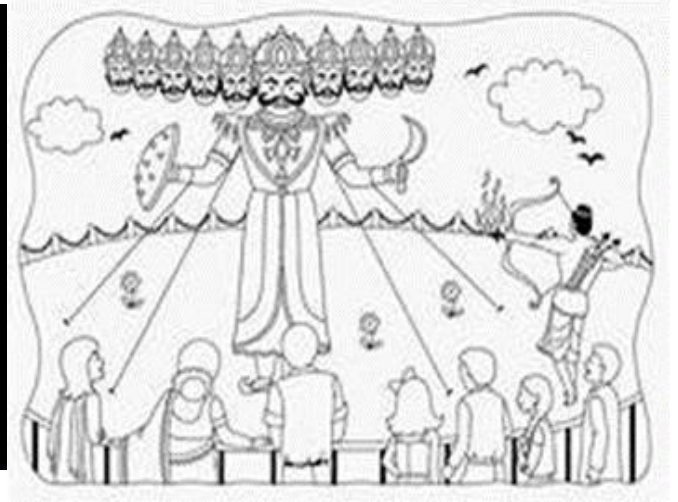

- d) What is a Constellation?

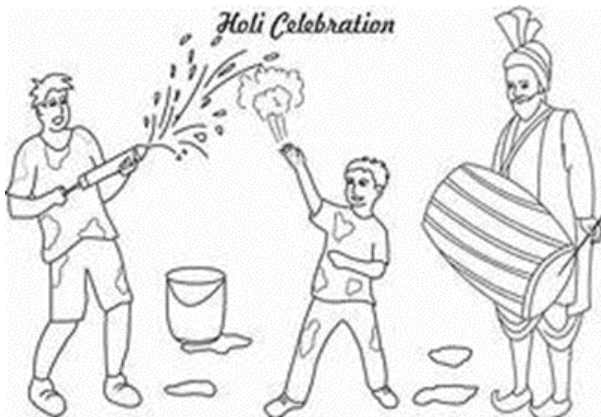
