The application should be sent in a sealed envelope duly superscribed **“APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR – SIGN LINGUISTICS”**. Application received after the closing date or without documents or otherwise Incomplete in any respect or send by E Mail will not be considered, under any circumstances.
